

Public Interest Disclosure (PID)

Central Regional TAFE is committed to the aims and objectives of the Public Interest Disclosure Act 2003 (PID Act).

The PID Act promotes accountability within government agencies and organisations by facilitating the disclosure of public interest information involving misconduct, offences, misuse of public resources or risks to public health or safety.

Before making a disclosure, contact the PID Officer in the relevant authority to find out:

- how to make the disclosure and to whom you should make it
- your rights and responsibilities, including your protections
- the types of information the PID Act covers
- whether making a public interest disclosure is the best avenue for you to use.

The **Manager Human Resources** (Telephone: 9622 6792) is the PID Officer for the College. This Officer is responsible for receiving disclosures of public interest information relating to matters falling within the sphere of responsibility of the College.
